



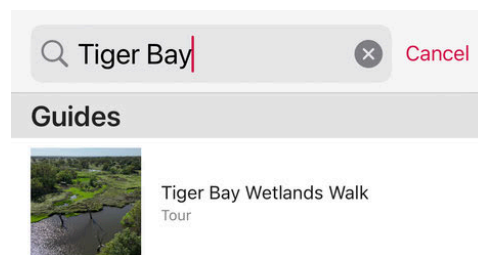
How to access the Tiger Bay Wetlands Self-guided Audio Walk

Download the free izi.TRAVEL app to enjoy a guided walk of the wetlands. Search for Tiger Bay Wetlands and you're ready to go!



There's a self-guided audio walk of Tiger Bay you can enjoy at any time by downloading the free izi.TRAVEL app on your Apple or Android phone or by using the browser on your phone e.g., Chrome or Safari. Use the camera on your smart phone to scan the QR code. Hold the camera up to the QR code until you see a link appear, then click on the link to take you to the Apple or Google App Stores, or the izi.TRAVEL website. The izi.TRAVEL app can be used at other sites around Australia and internationally. There are 20,000 audio guides hosted by izi.TRAVEL.

Open the app and type
Tiger Bay in the search bar.



When the subscribe window pops up, click on subscribe for an ad-free option (useful if you're going to be a frequent user) or click on the Remind Me Later option. You can download the walk in the app before heading off so you don't need a mobile connection while walking (it's 66MB).

There are 10 stops around the wetland where you can learn more about the biodiversity and ecology of the wetland, with links to more information in the text for each stop.
